

## SHRINE 2.0 Release Preview for ACT

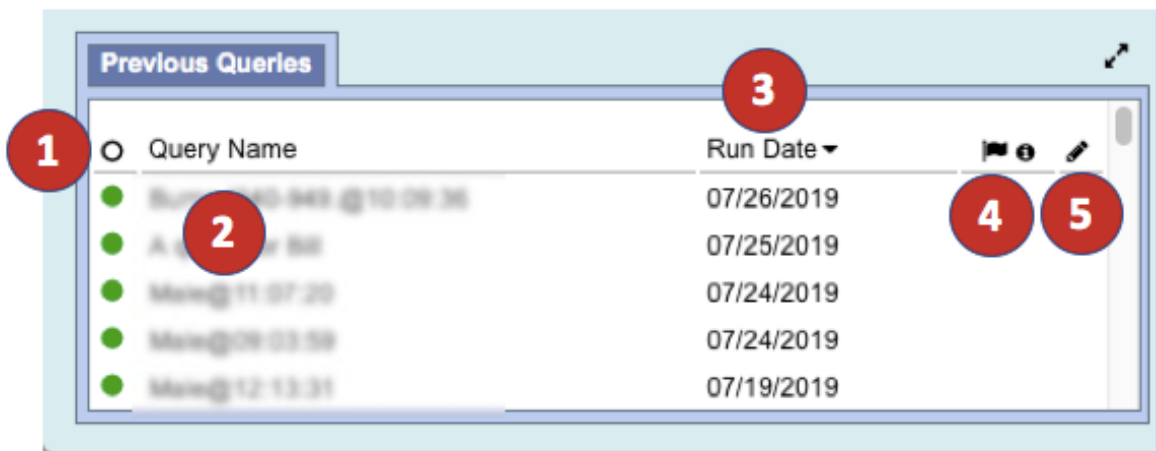
The ACT Network will upgrade to SHRINE 2.0 in fall 2019. SHRINE 2.0 completes foundational changes that will enable greater insight into network status and performance, as well as a few small changes to the web client. Key improvements are highlighted below.

### Query and Results Statuses in Query Status Panel

SHRINE 2.0 includes improvements to statuses of queries and query results, helping users better understand and track the progress of their query. Status text is color-coded, while numerical results are shown in black text:

- **Green text** statuses indicate a query in progress or completed
- **Orange text** indicates a delay
- **Red text** indicates an error
  - Received an error message from a site? Users can click to view additional details and possible steps to resolution.

### Previous Query Facelift



The Previous Queries panel (shown above) was redesigned to help users easily view, organize, and follow up on their list of previously-run queries. In the redesigned panel, users can:

1. Quickly identify their query status; a green dot for a successfully executed query or a red dot to re-run
2. See which queries contain updated results from a delayed site, indicated by a bold query name
3. Sort by run date or query name
4. View controls to flag a query\* with a message for follow up
5. Edit query name more easily

\*The flagged query feature is not intended for immediate use but will be important for future developments. More information on the function and use of this feature will be shared in the coming months.
